SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS:

High school-aged volunteers must attend *Called to Serve* training through the Archdiocese of Detroit in order to volunteer as **Station Leaders**. It is not required of station helpers and crew leaders/helpers.

SMQOC is hosting a *Called to Serve* Workshop on Saturday June 9, 9:00am till noon. Pre-registration required through the Faith Formation Office 586-725-7579.

Training workshops only need to be taken once and are valid for any parish-related service. This requirement can be completed within 6 months of beginning of service. Visit www.aodonline.org and follow the "Safe Environments" links to find a workshop that fits your schedule. Registration, transportation, and providing a copy of your certificate for our files is your responsibility

ALL adult volunteers must attend *Protecting God's Children* training through the Archdiocese of Detroit to volunteer with children at the parish.

IN ADDITION a background check must be completed for each adult and a background affidavit completed for each high school teen station leader. Forms are available at the faith formation office or parish office. **THIS REQUIREMENT MUST BE MET PRIOR TO VOLUNTEERING** and only needs to be completed once. All information provided is kept strictly confidential. Background information is handled at the home parish and NOT at the parish where you attend your workshop.
